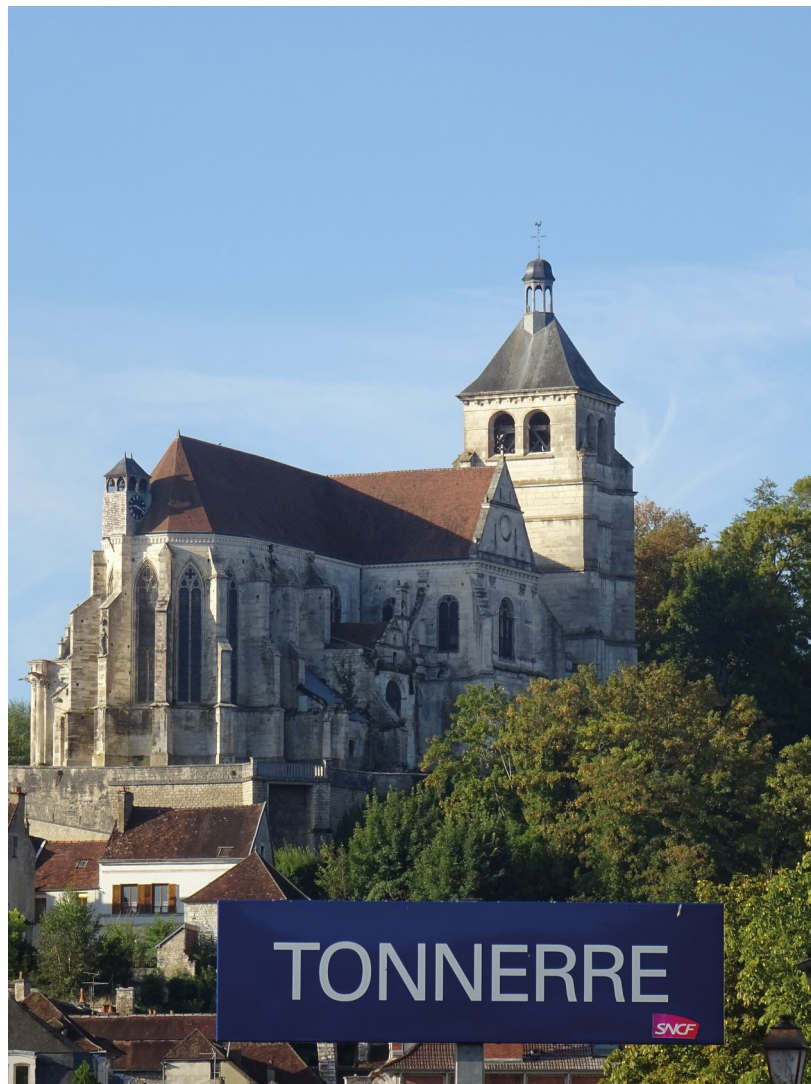


Baroque violin/viola masterclasses

Picturesque Tonnerre, situated by the Canal de Bourgogne, with historic churches, a medieval hospice, the Fosse Dionne karst spring and many other attractions.
